



EMAS ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

As a contribution to the Green Deal, the European Commission demonstrates its commitment to sustainable development, and sound environmental practice, by ensuring that it reduces the impact of its day-to-day activities in a manner consistent with the policies that it has developed for Europe.

Continuing efforts to improve its environmental performance that started in 1997, in 2005, the Commission achieved its first registration under the Eco Management and Audit Scheme (EMAS). In 2020, the Commission implements EMAS across its eight¹ largest sites in Europe. The Commission will endeavor to continue extending the scope of its registration to the Executive Agencies and to its representations across Europe.

The Commission will continue to protect the environment, including pollution prevention, and in 2019, her President, Ursula von der Leyen committed to make the Commission climate neutral by 2030.

Under EMAS the Commission seeks to continually improve its environmental management system and its environmental performance and therefore reduce the environmental impact of its everyday work in accordance to the UN's Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by:

- (1) Using natural resources more efficiently, particularly in relation to energy, water and products such as paper;
- (2) Continuously reducing our operations' atmospheric emissions (mainly from buildings operation and transport) with the objective of making the Commission climate-neutral by 2030;
- (3) Improving waste management and sorting, where waste prevention measures have been exhausted, so that waste recycling is optimised and residual waste reduced;
- (4) Protecting biodiversity;
- (5) Promoting sustainable and environmentally responsible public procurement procedures for example by introducing appropriate criteria into the tender and contract process, and incorporating life cycle cost considerations where feasible;
- (6) Ensuring (and demonstrating) compliance with environmental legislation and regulations including in relation to emergency preparedness, thereby reducing pollution risk;
- (7) Encouraging staff and contractors to embrace sustainable behaviour through improved internal communication, awareness-raising, and training; and
- (8) Enjoying transparent relations and dialogue with external parties, taking into account and addressing stakeholder expectations;
- (9) Improving the EMAS system including ensuring consistency with European Union policies.

Additionally, and though not falling within the EMAS scope, the Commission will ensure through assessments carried out by its services, that in relation to its core business, it will:

- (10) Systematically assess the potential economic, social and environmental impacts of major new policy and legislative initiatives and promote systematic integration of environmental objectives into Community policies;
- (11) Ensure the effectiveness of environmental legislation and funding in creating environmental benefits;

By virtue of the powers conferred on the Appointing Authorities, the European Commission's EMAS Steering Committee hereby approves this Policy Statement, commits to adopt the Commission's EMAS objectives, targets and action plan, to supervise the system's implementation and to monitor the use of its allocated staff and financial resources in order to ensure that the environmental management system runs efficiently.

IL-POLITIKA AMBJENTALI

Bhala kontribut għall-Patt Ekoloġiku, il-Kummissjoni Ewropea turi l-impenn tagħha għall-iżvilupp sostenibbli u għal prattiki ambjentali tajbin billi tiżgura t-naqqis tal-im-patt tal-attivitajiet tagħha ta' kuljum b'manjera konsistenti mal-politika li żviluppat għall-Ewropa.

Il-Kummissjoni ssukat issaħħaħ l-isforzi, li bdew fl-1997, fuq il-prestazzjoni ambjentali tagħha, u fl-2005 kisbet l-ewwel registrazzjoni skont l-Iskema ta' Mmaniġġjar u Awditjar Ekoloġiċi (Eco Management and Audit Scheme, EMAS). Fl-2020 il-Kummissjoni timplimenta l-EMAS madwar l-akbar trnien siti tagħha fl-Ewropa.

Il-Kummissjoni se tagħmel hilita biex tkompli testendi l-ambitu tar-registrazzjoni tagħha għall-Aġenziji Ezekuttivi u għar-rappreżentanzi tagħha madwar l-Ewropa.

Il-Kummissjoni se tkompli thares l-ambjent, fosthom il-prevenzjoni tat-triġġis u fl-2019, il-President tagħha, Ursula von der Leyen ikkommettiet ruħha li sal-2030 il-Kummissjoni jkollha impatt newtrali fuq il-klima.

Fl-isfond tal-EMAS il-Kummissjoni thabrek biex ittejjeb is-sistema ta' ġestjoni ambjentali

u l-prestazzjoni ambjentali tagħha u għaldaqstant tnaqqas l-impatt ambjentali tal-hidma tagħha ta' kuljum skont l-Għanijiet ta' Żvilupp Sostenibbli (Sustainable Development Goals, SDGs) tan-NU billi:

- (1) Tuża r-riżorsi naturali b'manjera aktar effiċjenti, partikolarment b'rabta mal-enġerġija, l-ilma u l-prodotti bħall-karti;
- (2) Tnaqqas kontinwament l-emissjonijiet atmosferiċi tal-operazzjonijiet tagħna (lakbar mill-operazzjoni tal-binjiet u tat-trasport) bil-għan li sal-2030 il-Kummissjoni jkollha impatt newtrali fuq il-klima;
- (3) Ittejjeb l-immaniġġjar u s-separazzjoni tal-iskart, fejn il-mizuri għall-prevenzjoni tal-iskart ikunu saru kollha, biex b'hekk ir-riċiklaġġ tal-iskart jiġi ottimizat u jtnaqqas l-iskart residwu;
- (4) Thares il-bijodiversità;
- (5) Tippromwovi proċeduri ta' akkwistpubbliku sostenibbli u ambjentalment responsabbli, pereżempju permezz tal-introduzzjoni ta' kriterji xierqa fil-proċess tal-offerti u tal-kuntratt, u tinkorpora kunsiderazzjonijiet taċ-ċiklu tal-hajja fejn dan ikun jista' jsir;
- (6) Tiżgura (u taghti prova) tal-konformità mal-legiżlazzjoni u mar-regolamenti ambjentali fosthom fir-rigward tat-thejjija għal emergenzi, biex b'hekk tnaqqas ir-riskju ta' triġġis;
- (7) Tinkoraġġixxi l-impjegati u tal-kuntratturi biex iħaddnu mgiba sostenibbli permezz tattitjib tal-komunikazzjoni interna, is-sensibilizzazzjoni u t-taħriġ, kif ukoll
- (8) Tibbenefika minn relazzjonijiet u djalogu trasparenti mal-partijiet esterni, permezz tal-kunsiderazzjoni u l-indirizzar tal-aspettattivi tal-partijiet ikkonċernati;
- (9) Ittejjeb is-sistema tal-EMAS fosthom l-iżgurar tal-konsistenza mal-politika tal-Unjoni Ewropea.

Barra minn hekk, u għalkemm ma taqas fl-ambitu tal-EMAS, abbażi ta' valutazzjonijiet mis-servizzi tagħha l-Kummissjoni se tiżgura, b'rabta mal-hidma ewlenija tagħha, li:

- (10) Taċċessa sistematikament l-impatti tal-inizjattivi ekonomiċi, soċjali u ambjentali potenzjali tal-inizjattivi politiċi u legiżlattivi ġodda u tippromwovi l-integrazzjoni sistematika tal-oġġettivi ambjentali fil-politika tal-Komunità;
- (11) Tiżgura l-effettività tal-legiżlazzjoni u l-finanzjament ambjentali waqt li tohloq benefiċċji ambjentali;

Bis-saħha tas-setgħat mogħtija lill-Awtoritajiet tal-Hatra, b'dan il-Kumitat ta' Tmexxija tal-EMAS tal-Kummissjoni Ewropea japprova din id-Dikjarazzjoni ta' Politika, jimpenja ruħu li jadotta l-oġġettivi, il-miri u l-pjan tal-azzjoni tal-Kummissjoni relatati mal-EMAS u li jssorvelja l-implimentazzjoni tas-sistema u jsewgi l-użu tal-impjegati u r-riżorsi finanzjarji allokati lili biex jiżgura li s-sistema ta' ġestjoni ambjentali taħdem b'mod effiċjenti.
